## EARLY HEAD START

Early Head Start will provide early, continuous, intensive, and comprehensive child development and family support services to pregnant women and families with children under three years of age. Early Head Start Programs are targeted for pregnant mothers 0-3 year-olds and will enhance and advance each child's development that supports the unique characteristics of infant and toddler physical, social, emotional, and cognitive growth. The program will empower parents in goal setting for themselves and for their children. The program will ensure a comprehensive network of services and support for young children and their families. Center and home based options are available.

### GREAT START READINESS PROGRAMS (GSRP)

The Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) is funded by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE). GSRP is a preschool program for four-year old children who may be "at risk" of school failure. This program allows children who qualify an opportunity to receive a high-quality preschool experience who may not otherwise have the chance.

The GSRP is Michigan's state-funded preschool program for four-year-old children with factors which may place them at risk of educational failure. The program is administered by the Michigan Department of Education, Office of Great Start. Research on preschool programs and specific research on GSRP indicates that children provided with a high-quality preschool experience show significant positive developmental differences when compared to children from the same backgrounds who did not attend a high-quality preschool program.

To strengthen learning at home and strengthen positive child outcomes, programs must provide for active and continuous involvement of parents in the learning process. Depending on income level, parents may be required to pay tuition, but parents are never charged additional fees for program elements such as transportation or meal service. Through advisory committees, parents assist to evaluate and make recommendations about the program.

**HEAD START**

Head Start programs promote school readiness by enhancing the social and cognitive development of children through the provision of educational, health, nutritional, social and other services to enrolled children and families. They engage parents in their child's learning and help them in making progress toward their educational, literacy and employment goals. Significant emphasis is placed on the engagement of parents in the administration of local Head Start programs.

**WHAT CAN THE HEAD START PROGRAM OFFER YOUR CHILD?**

Head Start provides children with activities that help them develop School Readiness Skills that include cognitive, social emotional, gross and fine motor skills as well as activities that encourage independence (self-help skills). The Head Start Staff recognize that, as parents, you are the first and most important teachers of your children. They welcome your involvement in Head Start activities, and will work as partners with you to help your child progress.

Head Start Staff are Qualified Early Child Development Professionals who use the High/Scope Curriculum (Active Learning) to offer your child the opportunity to learn through developmentally appropriate play and exploration and help them prepare for the next school placement. Head Start children socialize with others, problem solve and work on conflict/resolution skills. The children also improve their listening and speaking skills.

The children spend their time in stimulating settings where they are encouraged to form good health/nutrition habits. They are provided nutritious meals and snacks and are able to play outside whenever possible. They periodically take educational field trips to various areas in their communities. Your child will leave Head Start more prepared for Kindergarten, excited about learning, and ready to succeed.

Family Services Workers are able to work with families to assist in family goal setting and coordinating health, dental and other family services. Referrals to skilled professionals will be made should health concerns arise. Mental Health services and special needs referrals are available for children and families when needed.

The Head Start program provides comprehensive child development services for economically disadvantaged children and families, with a focus on school readiness which includes literacy and math skills that are needed to be successful in school.

**PRIVATE PRESCHOOL**

Private preschools operate as for-profits, independent nonprofits, and programs sponsored by religious organizations. Most are part-day programs. Though the margin is small, private preschools still claimed the majority of total preschool enrollment in 2001. The educational quality of private preschools varies from program to program. Regulation is primarily by state child care agencies, but the arrangement varies from state to state.

**GREAT START TO QUALITY AND STAR RATINGS**

Great Start to Quality helps parents find the best child care and preschool for their child, and helps providers improve the care and education they give to children. Standards set by Great Start to Quality are used to rate child care and preschool programs to ensure that Michigan's youngest children have high-quality early learning experiences.

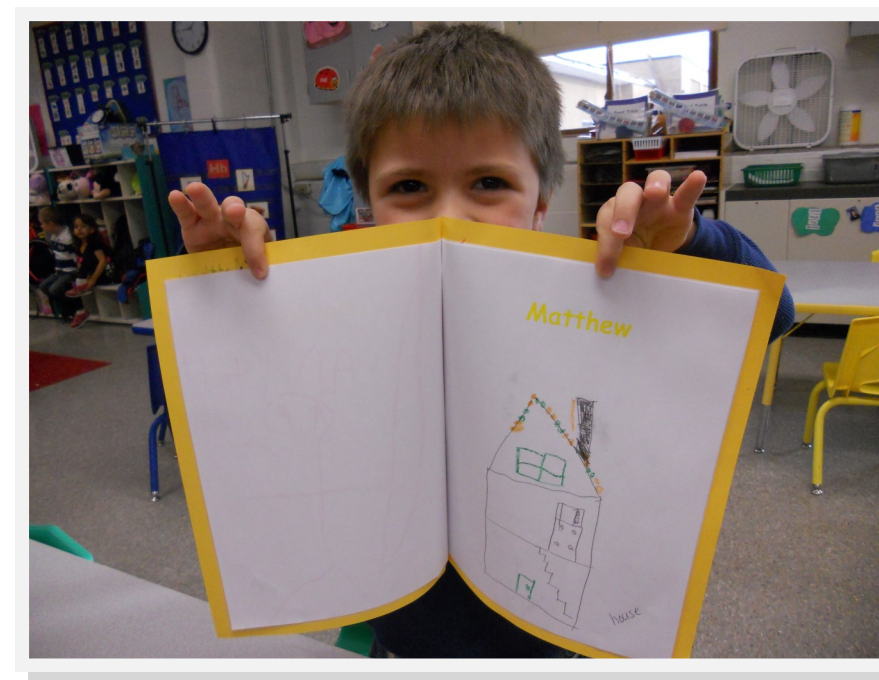
